

About Collaborative Literacy Correlation Spreadsheets

The Collaborative Literacy Correlations are intended to allow you, the teacher, to easily identify the standards addressed in each of the three programs, *Being a Reader™*, *Making Meaning®*, and *Being a Writer™*. There is a separate Excel workbook for each program, with a tab for each component by grade level. The workbook format allows you to sort by any column. We anticipate that the Lesson and Standard columns will be most helpful in this regard.

The individual spreadsheets in the workbooks are quite lengthy. As a consequence, if you wish to print from them, we suggest that when looking for a lesson or standard, you sort first and then highlight the standards you wish to print. Set the print area from the “Set Print Area” option on the File menu, and print that area.
