Intensive Multisensory Instruction for SIPPS®

Support for Students Identified with Dyslexia and other Learning Challenges

Students identified with dyslexia or other learning challenges benefit from simultaneous activation of learning modalities that include physical movement and tactile sensations. For these students, *Intensive Multisensory Instruction for SIPPS®* provides variations that can be readily added to the original *SIPPS* routines. These increased options allow teachers to adapt instruction to the needs of students.

Intensive Multisensory Instruction for SIPPS includes expanded routines for phonological awareness, phonics and sight words, and guided spelling. Expanded routines incorporate student arm and hand motions as well as tracing and writing and additional vocalization.

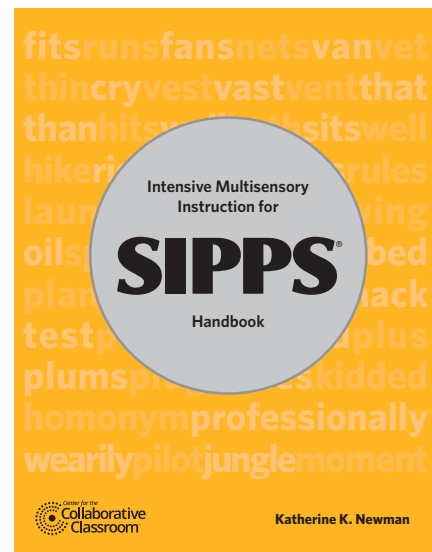
Enhancements for Multisensory Instruction

Teachers who use the *SIPPS* program are familiar with the multimodal nature of the routines that are already used in the program. With the addition of *Intensive Multisensory Instruction for SIPPS Handbook*, teachers have multisensory routines to strengthen the connections among the students' visual, auditory, and kinesthetic-tactile learning modes. These ideas can be smoothly incorporated into regular *SIPPS* lessons.

- Phonological awareness is enhanced by simultaneous hand movements or by moving markers to correspond with sounds.
- Phonics and sight words have added activities for tracing and writing.
- In guided spelling, students spell aloud as they write, and they point to each letter while spelling back what they have written.
- *Beginning Level* includes air and finger writing for phonics.
- *Challenge Level* includes tracing and writing of irregular sight syllables.

What's Included

Each level of *SIPPS* now includes an *Intensive Multisensory Instruction for SIPPS Handbook*. Additionally, there are consumable student materials that correspond to each level, and access to additional materials and videos on the CCC Learning Hub. This new component is also available for teachers already using the program.

The *SIPPS*® program for grades K–12 is a systematic decoding curriculum that helps struggling readers quickly develop word-recognition skills and reading fluency. The program can be used for grade-level or intervention instruction. Each *SIPPS* level corresponds to one level in a developmental progression: simple alphabetic, spelling pattern, and polysyllabic/morphemic phases. Initial and ongoing assessments allow teachers to place students in small groups according to where they are and move them along as quickly as they can progress. With the addition of *Intensive Multisensory Instruction for SIPPS*, teachers can now further support students with dyslexia and other learning challenges. Each *SIPPS* level now includes this component, but it can also be purchased separately for teachers already using the program.
